SL No	Name of the bidder	Reasons for their rejection
1	HS Enterprise Ltd	H.S. Enterprise submitted manufacture's authorization letter of Guangdong Yinhe Motorcycle Industry LTD stating that they were the official manufacturer of Emma Brand Motorcycle in the factory established in China. But the catalogue submitted by the bidder was of H.S. Enterprise Limited, Bangladesh without mentioning Technical Specifications. Moreover, Emma Brand motorcycle was not found in the list of the products of the said manufacturer's Web page (GUANGDONG YINHE MOTORCYCLE INDUSTRY COMPANY, LTD). The website of the H.S. Enterprise shows Emma motorcycle as one of its products marketed as its own brand name. In Bangladesh Yellow Pages H.S. Enterprises claims that Emma Motors is a sister concern of HSEL and is marketing motorcycles in its own brand name. Under the circumstances it was clear that the statements made in the so-called manufacturer's authorization letter was not true. Moreover, the bid of H.S. Enterprise did not meet the required Technical Specifications. The members of TEC termed this as a significant deviation, and due to the inconsistencies found in the Manufacturer's Authorization and catalogue, declared the bid of H.S. Enterprise non-responsive.

2	Momotaj Steel & Works	Momotaj Steel & Works was declared non-responsive because the bidders failed to meet the requirements of experience criteria of the bidder. Experience criteria required that a minimum of 1000 units of similar goods should be sold by the bidder and have been in operation satisfactorily for at least 3 years.
3	Roadmaster Motors Ltd	Roadmaster Motors Ltd did not submit bid submission sheet in accordance with the ITB clause 12,16 & 17 of the bidding documents. The bid did not fulfill the requirements of Technical Specifications and was declared non-responsive.
4	M..N. Mallick & Company	M.N Mallick & Company was declared non-responsive because the bidders failed to meet the requirements of experience criteria of the bidder. Experience criteria required that a minimum of 1000 units of similar goods should be sold by the bidder and have been in operation satisfactorily for at least 3 years.
5	Winner Industries	Winner Industries was declared non-responsive because the bidders failed to meet the requirements of experience criteria of the bidder.
